The Area

Just 65 miles northeast of Flagstaff, In the south-central area of the Navajo Reservation, there once was a lake in Tolani Lake. It dried up so many years ago that not many people remember but the community is still there.

Approximately 200 people call Tolani Lake home and within the cluster of homes there is a Navajo Chapter House, a community center and a school that's closed.
