

The Area

The landfall of Hurricane Dorian brought great destruction to the Abaco Islands on September 1, 2019. The effects of this Category 5 hurricane categorized it as the "worst natural disaster in the country's history" (The Guardian), leaving 70,000 displaced and severely damaging over 13,000 homes (GlobalNews.ca). The Abaco islands are located in the northeast section of the Bahamian islands and were one of the island groups that was hit the hardest.

Months have passed and countless tons of debris remain scattered amongst the island. The islands face a daunting long road of recovery. Due to the mass displacement and evacuation of residents and the crippled economy, there is a shortage of labor and a great need for people to help rebuild and restore these communities. There is much work yet to be done.
